



MINNESOTA PALOMINO HORSE EXHIBITORS FUTURITY 2008

Futurity classes to be held with multi-judged PBHA Shows
Windom, Minnesota – Cottonwood County Arena – August 23 & 24,
2008

\$3,000 Added Money by MPHE in 2008

GENERAL RULES

1. The MPHE Futurity is open to all registered Palominos or, in the case of weanlings, eligible to be registered with PHBA Owners and exhibitors must be members in good standing with PHBA
Exception: Entries in Rainbow classes
2. Judging System: A total of six judge's scores will be used with horses exhibiting in two go-rounds. A judge for each futurity class will be designated as a tie-breaker judge in the event of a tie. The tiebreaker judge will be designated before any of the judges have judged a futurity class. Ties are broken for awards by designated judge, but monies are combined and divided evenly.
3. Futurity classes will be held at the same time as the corresponding class in the regular PBHA show. Entries will be required to enter the corresponding open even except for Rainbow classes.
4. Official postmark will determine date of entry.
5. No changes or substitutions of horses.
6. No refunds for canceled entries regardless of reason unless entry qualifies under Rule #10.
7. Payback Schedule – Payback will be determined by the number of horses shown in each class.
Payback schedule as follows (less 20% per entry).
 - 1 Entry 100%
 - 2 Entries 60%, 40%
 - 3 - 5 entries 45%, 35%, 20%
- 6 – 11 entries 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%
- 12 or more entries 30%, 25%, 20%, 10%, 5%
8. Notify futurity secretary of any new information such as gelded stallions, names, sex, birth date, death, etc.
9. For all futurity classes, horses must be shown by the same exhibitor under all judges.
10. If an unborn nominated weanling is not Palomino in color or if the nominated weanling should die, the owner's entry will be carried over to the following year or applied to the Rainbow class. Owner must provide to the futurity secretary, PRIOR TO THE SHOW, Veterinary death certificate or proof of color registration papers.
11. Rainbow weanling, rainbow yearling longline and rainbow 2 & 3 year old Western Pleasure Class: These classes are open to all regardless of sex or color. This includes Palominos and non-Palominos. However, for non-Palomino entries, at least one parent must be a Palomino. This class is for prize money and awards only, no points will be awarded. The only fee for this class is the entry fee. No office / computer / drug fee will be collected. Proof of parent's color must be provided with entry fee of non-Palomino foals. All rules apply except where noted.

Bedding must be purchased from the arena. No outside bedding is allowed.
